REMOTE LEARNING PLAN

East Millinocket Schools will continue to provide learning opportunities for all students during the school closure. Please contact the school by phone (746-3511) or email (jpage@emmm.org) so that we can help meet your learning needs. The following is the learning plan that is currently in place:

Student Expectations:

- Grades 9-12
 - 2-3 hours of academic learning each day
 - At least 1 hour of physical activity (outside, if possible)
 - Check email and Google Classroom daily (if you have internet access)
 - Be available to receive phone calls and messages from teachers, M-F
 - Complete assignments in a timely manner (hard copies of all assignments will be available)
 - Be available for teacher instruction sessions being offered via Google Classroom, Google Hangouts, Zoom etc. (if you have internet access)

- Grades K-4
 - Week 1
 - Complete learning activities sent home by teachers
 - At least an hour of physical activity (outside, if possible)

 - Week 2
 - Connect with teachers via email, phone, Facebook (parent or student)
 - Continue to complete learning activities shared by teachers

 - Week 3 and beyond
 - A hybrid of weeks 1 and 2

Parent/Family Expectations:

- Communicate with the school via teachers, staff, counselors, or administration with any questions or concerns.
- Please look for updates on our website and Facebook pages.
- Please support children as needed with learning activities and assist them in keeping structured daily routine.

Daily Schedule:

In order to support families that would like to maintain a school schedule, students may follow the green/white schedule that has been established. Elementary students can choose to do their subject matter in the order it is presented to them throughout a regular school week.

(ex: Math first thing in the morning or after lunch, etc.) This should help provide balance and continuity to complete assignments in a timely manner.

Teacher Schedule:

8:00 am – 9:00 am

- Teachers and staff will use this time to prep for the day, adjusting lessons, monitoring and grading student work that has been completed.
- Check email for updates from administration and/or parent/student inquiries.

9:00 am – 2:00 pm

- Teachers and staff are available for check-ins, questions about assignments, or any other concerns that may arise. Please allow reasonable time for teachers to respond if communicating electronically.
- Teachers may be holding instruction based sessions, read alouds, check-ins, etc. via the Google platform, Zoom, or through other means of electronic communication.

2:00 pm – 3:00 pm

- Reflect on the day, making any necessary adjustments to lesson plans.
- Connect with colleagues to collaborate on student learning.
- Check email for updates from administration

Lesson Plans:

Each department will be working both independently and collaboratively when possible, to provide the most consistent ongoing instruction and learning possible. This may look different by subject and grade level, so please reach out to teachers and support staff if you have any questions.

Overall:

During the time of school closure it is critical that we maintain student learning and take advantage of the time we have to continue to work on an academic program. We understand that this is uncharted territory and many questions will arise. All staff are committed to providing support to students and families during this challenging time. Please continue to be available and responsive to the most recent updates and recommendations.
