Dear Parents/Guardians,

It looks like winter will be here before we know it! This letter is to inform you of what we will be doing at Schenck High School and Opal Myrick Elementary School in the event that inclement weather that makes transportation to school unsafe.

There will be no morning delays. A full “snow day” will be called if roads are too dangerous for travel in the morning hours. If Medway Middle School has a cancellation, all East Millinocket Schools will also be canceled. Parents will receive an automated message via voice call and/or text around 5:30 am if school is canceled. You will also be able to access school cancellation information through most local radio and news stations.

Opal Myrick Students will be receiving a “snow day bag” from their teachers. These “bags” are full of learning activities to be completed in the case of a snow day. Completion of this work enables us to not have to make up winter school cancellations at the end of the school year. Please do the best you can to complete this work with your child. If it is a hardship for your student to complete these, we fully understand and teachers are prepared to work with families if extra time and support is needed.

Schenck High School students will simply log on to their Google Classrooms for the classes they would have had to attend the day of the school cancellation. From there, they will complete assignments that are specifically intended and labeled for “snow days”. Completion of this work will count fully toward GPA and class rank. Extra time will be given to students to complete these assignments if extenuating circumstances permit (ex: power outage, internet outage, sickness, etc.).
